91.8% of spend within 40 miles

To support the local economy and lessen our impact on the environment, we aimed to maximise spend within the local area.



Designed to mimic the appearance of copper, this Kalzip roof was designed by Metclad and assembled like a jigsaw puzzle on site.

Every timber roof beam **cut to length on site**

To ensure every beam was the perfect length for this complex roof, every piece of timber was cut to length on site.

98.55% of waste diverted from landfill

Thanks to our close relationship with our partner Wastecycle, we were able to segregate or recycle over 55.5 tonnes of waste.

247m of paving laid in just 24 hours

Our specialist sub-contractors at Marshalls Paving managed to lay the entire 247m long path in just 24 hours.

Glazing design inspired by nature

To match the natural surroundings of Sherwood Forest, our glazing frames are inspired by tree branches.

Over 95% of exterior walls were curved
