

# Programme of Works Challenge

## Instructions

The aim of this challenge is for individuals to gain an understanding of the process of building a single house right from the beginning of setting out, through to the final stage of cleaning before handing over.

The challenge includes 3 different sets of cards (within the House Cards file) and a House Programme Solution. The first set of cards has all the different stages of a house build. The second set of cards includes different durations. The third set of cards include monetary values.

The aim of the challenge is for the individuals to place the first set of cards (different stages of a house build) in the order they think a house is built.

Once this section is complete, they will place the second set of cards (duration) alongside the first set of cards. This will help them to determine how long they think each section of a house build takes.

The final set of cards (monetary values) are placed alongside the previous sets of cards, and gets the individuals to think how much each section of a house build would cost.

During this challenge, the facilitator will have the House Programme Solution and will help guide the individuals through the challenge.

Once they are happy with their selections, the individuals will be able to view the House Programme Solution to see how they performed against the programme.

A final discussion will then be held on how the individuals found the challenge and what they have understood from being involved on the challenge.
